The Jan Mahlman Literacy Grant is named for its benefactor, who taught first and second graders at Meadow Lane Elementary School for 35 years. Grants up to \$1,000 are awarded for projects related to literacy preparation or literacy improvement in grades pre-kindergarten to grade 2. Applicants must be verified current members of the Lincoln Education Association with teaching assignments in Pre-Kindergarten to grade 2.

The application must be completed online or typewritten and received at the LEA office by **4:00 pm, January 16, 2024**. Recipients will be notified by February 15, 2024. Recipients must send a short evaluation of the project's success to the LEA office in the form of written report, portfolio, or video by the end of the school year.
